Missouri Commission on the 150th Anniversary of the Civil War

- Kick-off April 12, 2011
- Missouri was the northern-most slave State and 3rd in number of Civil War battles behind Tennessee and Virginia
- The commission has four committees: Tourism and Marketing; Historic Preservation; Information and Education; and Special Projects.
- Tim Symington: we need to work on trail projects (such as Gray Ghost Trail); getting Google links promoted correctly for MO Civil War Commission; and fostering reconciliation.

Camp Jackson: the Tipping Point

- Presentation by Frank Aufmuth
- Event is April 29 – May 1 at Jefferson Barracks
- This event will be the first event in Missouri celebrating the 150th anniversary of the Civil War
- There will be 200 re-enactors
- Expected to draw 20,000 spectators
- There is a curriculum online and 500 school children are coming
- Mr. Aufmuth is offering the opportunity to have advertising space in the event program or just an outright donation
- Money will be used for entertainment, sanitary needs, hay and straw and insurance
- Checks can be mailed to Pam Sanfillipo and be made out to JNPA (Jefferson National Parks Association)
- JBCC Board has recommended making a \$100 donation to the event.
- The general membership voted and the motion carried.
